# JEFFERSON COUNTY PUBLIC SEWER DISTRICT REGULAR MEETING MINUTES July 27<sup>th,</sup> 2022

A regular meeting of the Jefferson County Public Sewer District (JCPSD) was held on Wednesday, July 27<sup>th,</sup> 2022, at 6:00 PM, in the Conference Room of the JCPSD offices, 4629 Yeager Rd., Hillsboro, MO 63050.

**Trustees present:** Chairman Peter Birkes, Vice Chairman Clyde Pratt, Secretary David Keeley, and Financial Officer Bill Eultgen were all present. There is one open seat.

**Call to Order / Roll Call:** Chairman Peter Birkes called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM, noting we have a quorum, Peter Birkes, David Keeley, Bill Eultgen, and Clyde Pratt all reported in attendance.

The Board requested confirmation on the asphalt (chip & seal versus 3 inch asphalt overlay) Rick Williams answered to stay with the 3 inch asphalt overlay, as that is what was agreed from the very first Sewer Improvement meeting with Weber Hill Subdivision and Jefferson County Sewer District.
